MODULAR COURSES IN INTERIOR DESIGN.

Interior Design:

Interior Design pedagogy is an integral knowledge that deals designing of Interior Built Spaces. It is the art and science that deals with space planning within the building with appropriate synergy to cater to the purpose, anthropometrics, ergonomics, aesthetics, balance between natural and artificial resources etc. to suit the user. Such Space planning may relate to a small residential space to a villa, a shop to a department store, individual's office to a multinational company, a café to a specialty restaurant, a reception area to a star hotel lobby.

Course Preamble

Format of the Courses:

The Modular courses in Interior Design are designed to suit both weeklong and weekend education seekers. Both the courses have 4 Modules curated to derive an appropriate sequence of knowledge from fresher to professional. The courses are formally termed as:

Weeklong Course

1) Four Module Full time course in Interior Design

Weekend Course

2) Four Module Part time course in Interior Design

Each Module is of 16 weeks with Module 1&2 in the 1st year and Module 3&4 in the second year. Every module has subjects framed in hierarchy of the knowledge perceived.

In Four Module **Full time** course in Interior Design, at the end of every Module (M) i.e. M1, M2, M3 & M4 there is an examination conducted to evaluate the skillsets gained at that stage.

In Four Module **Part time** course in Interior Design at the end of Module 1&2 i.e. M1 & M2 there is a combined examination conducted to evaluate the skillset gained at that Elementary stage. At the end of Module 3&4 i.e. M3 & M4 there is a combined examination conducted to evaluate the skillset gained at the Concluding stage.

In both the Modular courses it is only after successful completion of the all the 4 Modules the Certificate of qualification is granted by the Institute.

Module- 3 (16 weeks):

- Professional Practice, Estimating & Costing.
- Working Drawing / Furniture Detailing.
- Advance Interior Services – Artificial Ventilation, Air conditioning,
- Set Design
- Interior Design – Commercial / Office Module
- AutoCad (3d Drawings)

Module- 4 (16 weeks):

- Vastu Shastra
- Working Drawing / Furniture Detailing.
- Advance Interior Services - Fire-Fighting, Surveillance system.
- Show window display / Exhibition Display.
- Interior Design – Hospitality Module
- AutoCad (3d Drawings)

Note: For 4 Module Part Time course, subjects like communication skills, Theory of Design are taken as part of the Interior design subject. Subject swap may happen within Mod. 1&2 Mod. 3&4 for sake of understanding and availability of visiting Industry professional

Salient features of the Course Content:

- The syllabus is designed to suit the contemporary Trends of the Industry.
- The course content is evaluated every 3 years and revisions are done for making it state of the art.
- Vastu Shastra, Set Design, Show Window Display, Exhibition Display are few Unique Selling Proposition (USP's) of the course content. These subjects are the need of the hour in Interior Design profession.
- Compulsory 4days 3 nights documentation study tour and Industrial visits.

Admission Eligibility:

Weeklong Course

1) Four Module Full time course in Interior Design

Eligibility: **S**econdary **S**chool **C**ertificate (SSC) passed or equivalent board.

Recommended for Candidates:

- Completed their education only till SSC or equivalent board.
- Unfortunately could not seek admission in other courses of interior design due to unavailability of seats.
- Consider the syllabus more suitable for their future prospects.
- Wish to complete the Interior Design education in two years.
- Prefer afternoon batch timings.

Weekend Course

2) Four Module Part time course in Interior Design

Eligibility: **S**econdary **S**chool **C**ertificate (SSC) passed or equivalent board.

Recommended for Candidates:

- Primarily this course is meant for working Professionals. This course gives flexibility of working throughout the week and attend the weekend course to perceive Interior Design.
- Already working in the field of Interior design or allied field and would like to simultaneously perceive formal education.
- Completed their education only till SSC or equivalent board.
- Unfortunately could not seek admission in other courses of interior design due to unavailability of seats.
- Consider the syllabus more suitable for their future prospects.
- Wish to complete the Interior Design education in two years.

Criteria:

Admissions are granted on the first come first confirm basis, till the admissions are available as per intake capacity.

Intake for Academic Year 2020-2021:

Weeklong Course –

Four Module Full time course in Interior Design = **40 seats / batch**

Weekend Course –

Four Module Part time course in Interior Design = **40 seats.**

Online registration form for Admission & Counselling:

The Candidates aspiring to take admission to Modular courses in Interior Design shall fill the **Online form** for the Interior Design Courses at L.S. Raheja School of Interior Design available on the institute website www.lsrso.edu.in under the drop down menu of admission – Modular courses in Interior Design. The eligible candidates shall select appropriate options on the online form after reading the admission manual.

Online Webinar / Counselling session shall be held in batches for aspiring students.
